

YOUTH ART CLASSES – FALL SESSIONS

My youth classes are designed to help students explore a variety of art materials, techniques, and creative approaches—tailored to their age and skill level. Class sizes are kept small (min. 2, max. 6) so every student gets personal attention.

CLASS GROUPS

Doodle Bugs (Recommended for Ages 5–7 - 1 hr)

For our youngest artists, focusing on early artistic development through fun, simple projects and a variety of art materials.

Creative Kiddos (Recommended for Ages 8–12 - 1 hr)**

Perfect for students with some art experience, exploring a variety of mediums through engaging small projects.

Art Adventurers (Recommended for Ages 13 & up - 1 hr, 1½ hrs or 2 hr)**

For older or more advanced students ready for longer, more in-depth projects and advanced skills.

Small Group / Private Lessons or Classes

**** 1 hrPLUS** – This applies to those students who are at a higher skill level (intermediate/advanced) but are attending a 1 hour class. Their projects will be tailored to their skill Level determined by instructor.

1 hr class – \$80 | Introductory–Intermediate level. Typically a new project each week.

1½ hr class – \$100 | Advanced. For students with strong skills, working on challenging projects tailored to their interests.

Thursday - 7 wk class: 1 hr class – \$112 | Introductory–Intermediate level. Typically a new project each week.

CLASS SIZE:

MINIMUM 2 - MAXIMUM 6-8 STUDENTS PER CLASS (DEPENDING ON AGE & ABILITY)

PAYMENT

Due: On or before the first class (unless otherwise arranged)

Methods: Cash, check (payable to Sundius Design), or credit card (fees may apply)

Education Financial Account (EFA) – Vendor on ClassWallet (Artistic Exploration - Artist, Marilee Sundius - Sundius Design). Those who register payment with this program, will receive an emailed invoice from me/Sundius Design, that can be submitted to ClassWallet for payment.

CANCELLATION POLICY

As a courtesy to our instructing artists and required class preparation, we have developed the following refund policies.

Student Withdrawal - A full refund, less a \$25 cancellation fee, will be given to students who withdraw from a class at least **5 days before it begins**. No portion of the tuition paid will be refunded after the first class of the session*.

Notification of withdrawal - must be made via email, artistic.exploration51@gmail.com or phone, 603-279-1255.

*Cancellation due to medical concerns will be considered for possible refund. The opportunity to make up a missed class(es) – limited to one class per session, due to illness or personal reasons will be considered. There will be No refunds or credits for missed classes, unless prior notification has been given and arranged.

Cancellation of Classes - If a class is canceled due to insufficient enrollment, students will be notified prior to the start date and will receive a full refund.

Weather, Unforeseen Cancellation, or Delay - In case of inclement weather or other unforeseen events, Marilee Sundius will reach out via text message or email to notify you of class cancellation or delay.

If classes are canceled due to weather or any unforeseen circumstance, Marilee Sundius will do her best to reschedule canceled class(es) on the next available date - in most cases, the class will be extended by one week. If for some reason a class cannot be rescheduled, participants will receive a refund for the canceled class(es) or a credit that can be used towards another session/class within one year of the date of issue.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR

Students are expected to respect both their fellow participants and the instructor to ensure a positive, productive, and enjoyable class environment. While socializing is welcome, students must be able to sit or stand attentively, listen to instructions, and demonstrate interest in completing the day's project. The goal is to foster a fun, creative experience where everyone can focus, participate fully, and complete their work.

FAQ

Q. *What ages do you teach?*

A. I have worked with a variety of ages and abilities. Most of my classes are mixed ages however I do try to keep the age range similar, however it is not always guaranteed as sometimes the time of the class or other accommodation will take precedent.

Q. *Do I have to stay with my child during class?*

A. I encourage parents/guardians to take the class time for themselves. I love working with the kiddos and giving them the opportunity to create freely and enjoy the social collaboration with other students. Due to the size of the space and class size it may not be possible for the parent to be in the classroom, however they can arrange to be close by and/or provide a contact phone number. If your child has any "special needs", please speak with me to make arrangements.

Q. *Do you follow a Home-school curriculum?*

A. No, however many of my projects may fulfill curriculum requirements. My classes are geared towards learning about art through exposure to a variety of mediums, techniques and projects. We experiment, practice, learn, create and have fun! I try to incorporate a bit of science, history and maybe sometimes a little math. Due to the mixed age and ability, not all projects are successful for everyone, but the goal is to have fun with the creative process and THERE IS NO SUCH THING AS BAD ART! They will all have their own individual outcome.

Q. *How much individual attention do you give the students?*

A. I try to give everyone the encouragement that I am able! I am there to share my passion for art and to instruct them and bring out their inner creativity! While I will follow along with the student and give feedback on their work, some kiddos rely on their own creativity. I am there to help you child enjoy this experience of creating and expression.

Q. *Do you give work outside of class?*

A. Sometimes I will encourage work outside of class or extend an activity/project to be completed at home. Occasionally I will provide a fun activity for them to do at home throughout the session. Most of the time it is optional, however sometimes the next class project will depend on the completion of the at home work in order to complete the in class project. I do try to give plenty of warning :-)
